Time Commitment

What's Involved

Work with NLRA staff to run drop-in family programs at Grey Rocks Conservation Area.

- Use seasonal topics that connect people to nature
- Support exploration of Grey Rocks and naturethemed craft
- Nature Station events happen twice a month throughout the year
- 2.5 hours per event including set-up and take down.

Volunteer Responsibilities

- Set up Nature Station materials at Grey Rocks Conservation Area prior to each Nature Station event.
- Be available throughout the event to welcome participants, alert Grey Rocks visitors that they can
 participate in the event, answer questions, and engage and interact with program participants
- Break down event and return all materials to NLRA in a timely manner.
- Report total time spent volunteering including date and hours worked using the Volunteer Log Form.

Requirements

- Have an interest in promoting conservation principles and connecting the community to nature.
- Volunteers will wear a nametag clearly visible during the event
- Able to lift 25 lbs.
- Be able to transport materials to/from Grey Rocks
- Have access to a cell phone during the event

NLRA Responsibilities

- Provide adequate training of all volunteer responsibilities and ongoing support.
- Provide all necessary supplies and materials for Nature Station.
- Keep regular, open communication with volunteers to answer volunteer questions and concerns.
- Keep an official record of volunteer information, including information from the volunteer log form.
