Hydrilla- EXOTIC

Hydrilla verticillata



Tuber in sediments



Leaves in 3s or 5s whorled around stem with curling tips, very toothed or serrated on edges

Brazilian elodea- EXOTIC

Egeria densa



Leaves in 4s or 8s whorled around stem with broader leaves, slightly toothed at edges

Waterweed- NATIVE

Elodea nuttallii



Leaves in 3s whorled around stem with narrow leaves, no teeth on margins of leaf

Waterweed- NATIVE

Elodea canadensis



Leaves in 3s whorled around stem with broader leaves, no teeth on margins of leaf
